

2. Make, model, and license plate number of vending unit
3. Owner's contact information
4. Operator's contact information
5. Type of vendor (street vending unit or sidewalk vending unit)
6. Copy of approved permit from the Carroll County or Douglas County Health Department
7. List of operating locations and times
8. Signatures from property owners indicating consent for the use of their property
9. Signature of applicant indicating agreement to the listed requirements

Sec. Prohibited conduct and requirements.

- A. Except for ice cream trucks, no food truck vendor shall operate on any day other than Monday unless such sale is in conjunction with a City approved special event or film production permit.
- B. Except for ice cream trucks, no food truck vendor shall conduct business or operate in the public right-of-way.
- C. A food truck vendor shall not operate on any private property without the prior consent of the owner.
- D. A food truck vendor shall maintain a \$1,000,000.00 liability insurance policy. Proof of current liability insurance, issued by an insurance company licensed to do business in Georgia, protecting the food truck vendor, the public and the city from all claims for damage to property and bodily injury, including death, which may arise from operation under or in connection with the permit. Such insurance shall name the city as an additional insured and shall provide that the policy shall not terminate or be canceled prior to the expiration date without 30 days advanced written notice to the city.
- E. Except for ice cream trucks, a food truck vendor shall not make sounds or announcements to call attention to the food truck either while traveling on the public rights-of-way or when stationary. At all times said food truck vendor shall be in compliance with the City of Villa Rica noise ordinance.
- F. The license under which the food truck vendor is operating must be firmly attached and visible on the mobile food truck vendor at all times.
- G. Any driver of a food truck vendor motorized vehicle must possess a valid Georgia driver's license.
- H. Except for ice cream trucks, food truck vendors are allowed only in the Downtown Central Business District.
- I. Food truck vendors shall not be located within 15 feet of any street intersection or pedestrian crosswalk or 10 feet of any driveway.
- J. No sale or offer for sale shall be made by any food truck vendor between 9:00 pm and 6:30 am unless such sale is in conjunction with a City approved special event or film production permit.
- K. Vending structures shall not be left unattended or stored at any time on the open vending site when vending is not taking place or during restricted hours of operation.
- L. No sale or offer for sale of ice cream, frozen milk, frozen dairy or ice confection products shall be made from a food truck vendor unless each side of the vehicle is marked, in

letter and numbers at least 3 inches in height, with the name and address of the food truck vendor licensee.

- M. The food truck vendor shall comply with all state, federal and local health and safety regulations and requirements and shall obtain and maintain any and all licenses required by any other health, organization or governmental organization having jurisdiction over this subject matter.
- N. The following safety regulations shall apply to any and all vehicles operating under this article or used for mobile retail food establishments:
 - 1. Every vehicle shall be equipped with a reverse gear signal alarm with a sound distinguishable from the surrounding noise level.
 - 2. Every vehicle shall be equipped with two rear-vision mirrors, one at each side, firmly attached to the outside of the motor vehicle, and so located as to reflect to the driver a view of the highway to the rear, along both sides of the vehicle.
- O. The food truck vendor may sell food and non-alcoholic beverage items only.

Sec. Indemnity.

As part of the permitting process set forth herein, any person or entity receiving a permit set forth herein shall execute an indemnity agreement indemnifying and releasing the City of Villa Rica, its agents, employees and elected officials from any and all liability against any and all claims, actions and suits of any type whatsoever.

Sec. Revocation and suspension.

The city shall have the right to revoke or suspend any license granted hereunder.

Sec. Fee.

The fee for every application for license under this section shall be set by the City Council.

2.

All ordinances, parts of ordinances, or regulations in conflict herewith are repealed.

3.

Severability. Should any court of competent jurisdiction declare any section of this Ordinance invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, which is not specifically declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.

4.

It is the intention of the Mayor and Council, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the City of Villa Rica Code of Ordinances, and the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish such intention.

5.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its adoption, the public welfare demanding it.
